

Little – Drawing Supplies

Charcoal – willow medium sticks, loose

Charcoal pencils – HB, 2B and 4B – 2 – 3 of each

Kneaded eraser – larger size

Gum eraser – it's a square block, tan

Paper – your choice, white, tan or gray – size 18x24 – Strathmore pad – wire bound

I will always have paper and misc. stuff on hand so no stress there.

Little – Painting Supplies

Firstly, please don't stress about this stuff – if you have painting supplies that will do fine. Just make sure you have semi-decent brushes, and paint from this century~

Paint – Acrylic or oil is fine

Titanium white – larger tube if possible

Cadmium yellow medium

Cadmium Red medium

Ultramarine Blue

Cerulean Blue (just because ultramarine can be overwhelming at times)

There is a wide range of paint available – watch pricing but do not buy student grade paint – it's too thin and transparent for the most part.

Utrecht, Gamblin, Golden, Liquitex are decent brands. Windsor Newton is good as well, if a bit pricey.

Brushes – #4 6 and 10 filbert or flat. Eventually you will need a couple of rounds.

8-10 **canvas panels** 8x10 and 11x14 – don't bother right now with linen – cotton acrylic primed panels will work well as a start.

We will incorporate more colors as we progress but this is a decent start.
