

Craig Pursley Supply List

Supplies You Will Need to Bring for the Portrait Session:

- French Easel or equivalent. Table top easel will also work as long as it is sturdy.
- Brushes – One good fine point #4 round, #4, #6, #8 Flats or Filberts (these are roughly one half inch wide to an inch wide)
- Canvases – Three or four 11x14 canvases, either stretched or canvas panels are fine
- Paint - Good quality oil paint- Titanium or Permalba white, Cadmium yellow light, Naples Yellow, Cadmium red light, Alizarin crimson, Cadmium orange, Viridian, Ultramarine blue, Raw sienna, Burnt umber, Burnt sienna, Permanent Rose
- Miscellaneous - Odorless Turpenoid, paint rag or roll of paper towels (Viva is best), small bottle of Liquin, palette, palette knife, small plastic bag for trash
- I will have several photos of faces from which to work or you are welcome to bring your own.
- Smock, apron or something to protect clothes from paint. Or just wear crummy clothes
- Also you will need a sack lunch for each session
