

Two Day Intermediate Class Recommended Student Supply List

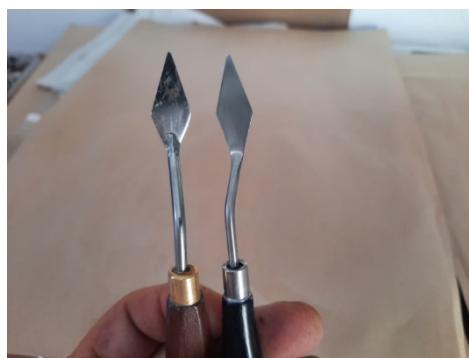
1. **Sennelier Oil Pastels**, set of 24 or 48. *This brand is highly recommended as the student will not have the same experience if a student grade is used. One or two Sennelier Grand Oil Pastels.* Grandes are the size of 8 regular oil pastels and are very cost effective when covering large areas. You may want to get one White (for color blending) and one or two of the main colors (example: Blue for your sky) for you project. Go online to www.DickBlick.com , www.JerrysArtarama.com , Ebay or Amazon. Made in France, have been some supply issues lately.
2. **Sennelier Oil Pastel fixative spray**. SEE PICTURE. *This fixative is highly recommended because of its unique properties. During class it is used extensively as a barrier between layers of oil pastel and as a final coating. This fixative dries fast, and accepts oil pastel on top of it unlike other brands.*
3. **Two to Three paint brushes**. Fine tipped oil/acrylic to medium sized watercolor brushes. *For washes and micro detailing. Any brand works.*
4. **Latex gloves**, if you want to use them rather than using fingers directly.
5. **130 lb 18"x 24" cold press watercolor paper**.
6. **A 24"x36" MDF or Styrofoam board**. *Base for watercolor paper, to use as a palette while painting, and to make transporting your project easier.*
7. **Approximately 8 oz. of odorless turpenoid**. *For washes, thinning oil pastel and cleaning brushes. Any brand will do. Be sure to bring a small dish to pour it into.*
8. **One Liquitex size 6 (or equal) palette knife**. SEE PICTURE. *The palette knife must have a sharp tip and be small enough for detail work to add and remove oil pastel.*
9. **One Armadillo size 0, firm edge chisel shaped (or equal) color shaper**. SEE PICTURE. *Optional but useful for detail work.*
10. **Paper towels**. *For blending oil pastel, cleaning your brushes. Oil pastels clean up with soap and water.*
11. **Masking Tape**. *To place on the back of the watercolor paper to hold it onto the MDF/Styrofoam board. Blue painter's tape is not strong enough.*
12. **Lunch** Lunch is sometimes available for order at the front desk. Call SAS at 480 990-1422 to find out if it will be available.

Oil pastel sets and/or other class materials may be available to purchase at class time. Call Scott Turner at 602.577.4504 to verify availability and to reserve your materials two weeks prior to class. Payment is made directly to the instructor at the beginning of the class.
